The other component involves students who will be transferring into Chicago State University the following year. These students will develop a general understanding of the nature of scientific inquiry and research before they participate in the transfer summer science program.

Areas of research will include Biological Sciences (Genetics, Microbiology, Exercise Physiology and Environmental Biology), Chemistry, Math/Computer Science and Physics.

AMP-SSI-CCT provides excellent opportunities for African Americans, Hispanic/Chicano Americans and Native Americans to experience the excitement of "hands-on" science. It allows the participant to enhance awareness of majors and careers in science, and get a jump start at successfully completing the transition process from community colleges to four year universities.

This program is for students who plan to attend Chicago State University and enroll in the Sciences in the fall semester of 1997.
