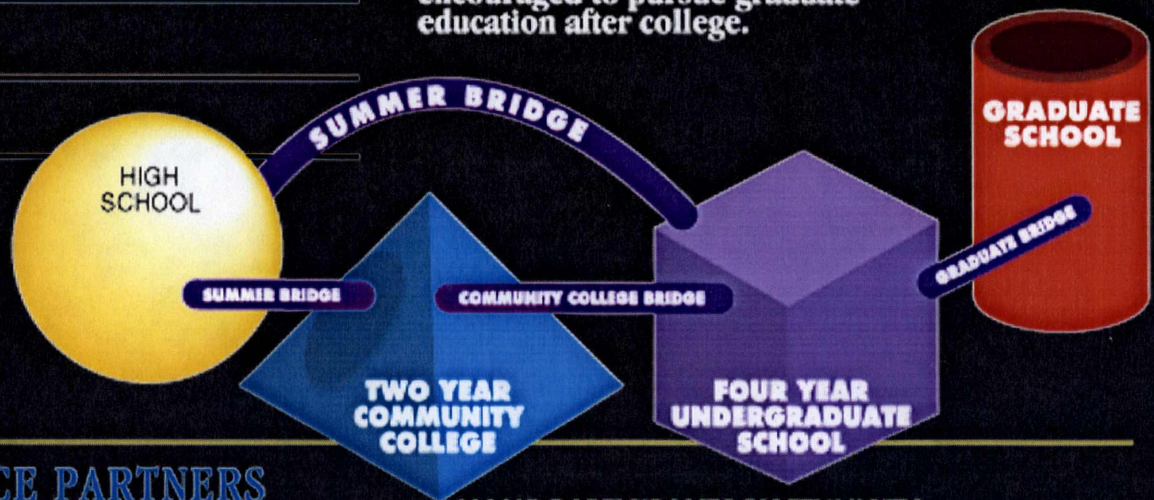

We are committed to increasing the numbers of highly qualified minority students who receive baccalaureate degrees in science, mathematics, engineering and technology. 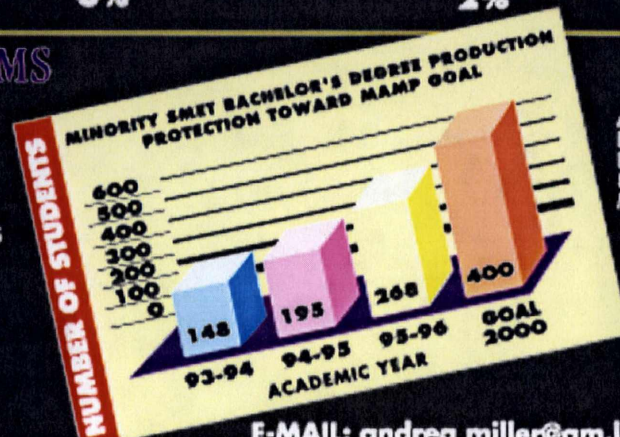
