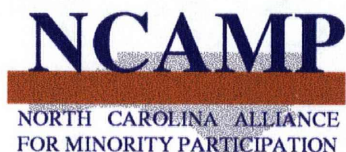


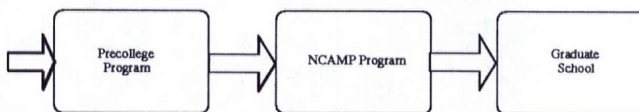
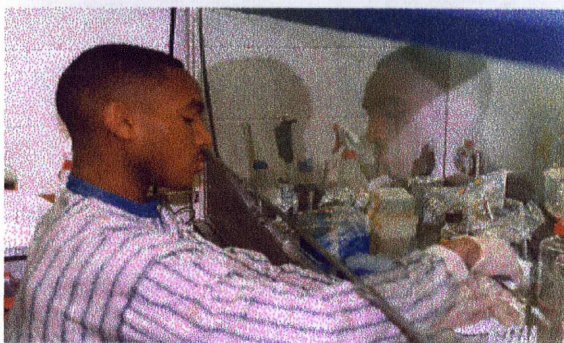
# North Carolina Alliance for Minority Participation (NCAMP)

Institutions participating in the North Carolina Alliance for Minority Participation (NCAMP) believe very strongly in its slogan, "building a stronger partnership for success." The combined efforts of all partners have resulted in programs geared to enhance student success through initiatives such as bridge programs, supplemental instruction, undergraduate research, and summer internships. These programs support approximately 4,765 minority students enrolled in science, mathematics, engineering, and technology (SMET) disciplines at partner institutions. More importantly, approximately 840 students earned degrees in SMET fields during the past academic year. Due in part to their exposure to undergraduate research experiences, many of these graduates have been motivated to enter graduate school to pursue the M.S. and Ph.D. degrees.
