

ALLIANCES FOR MINORITY PARTICIPATION

A National Program

he Alliance for Minority Participation (AMP) program is a multidisciplinary, comprehensive undergraduate program designed to increase, substantially, the quantity and quality of minority students receiving baccalaureate degrees in science, engineering, and mathematics (SEM) and, subsequently, to increase the number of minority students entering graduate schools to attain the doctorate in SEM fields supported by the NSF. To utilize the knowledge, resources, and capabilities of a broad range of organizations within the SEM community, AMP encourages the formation of coalitions among leaders throughout academia, government, industry, and other organizations. The program will maximize the potential for making a significant positive impact on minority participation over the next decade. Success of the AMP program will be measured by the program's ability to bring about a significant increase in the number of underrepresented minorities graduating with a baccalaureate degree in SEM fields supported by NSF.

The AMP program, the goal of which is to increase the size of the pool of interested and academically qualified underrepresented minority students eligible for SEM graduate study, supports the establishment of comprehensive approaches to increase the quantity and quality of underrepresented minorities successfully completing SEM baccalaureate degree programs.

AMP facilitates achievement of the long-term goal of increasing the production of minority doctorates in SEM fields, especially those who choose to take faculty positions on college and university campuses. The required sustained and comprehensive action will be accomplished through the formation of alliances in partnership with the Foundation. Full participation by the SEM community is essential to the achievement of program goals.

The substantial majority of activities intended for NSF support under the AMP program must focus specifically on undergraduate SEM education. In addition to this principal focus, projects must also give consideration to the critical transition points along the SEM education pipeline (i.e., high school to college; two-year to four-year college; undergraduate to graduate study; and graduate study to faculty career). The scope and scale of an AMP project (i.e., the number of transition points addressed) may vary among proposals, depending on project focus, needs, and goals.

THE ALABAMA PROGRAM

labama Alliance for Minority Participation is an Alliance consisting of the National Science Foundation, eight Historically Black Colleges and Universities, three majority universities, and five national and international businesses with a single goal of significantly increasing the number of minorities receiving baccalaureate degrees in science, engineering, and mathematics in Alabama and portions of the South. Conceived and initiated by ten black faculty members at these institutions with Ph.D. degrees in mathematics and science, Alliance programs include:

- AMP Scholars A group of high achieving minority students, supported by Alabama AMP, forming a nucleus or core of successful science, engineering, and mathematics students and role models at each Alliance institution. These students lead study groups and serve in the AMP Drop-In Centers.
- AMP Summer Research Internship Program A program involving students from the Alliance institutions in research activities, mentoring, and science career seminars. Students prepare research projects for presentation at the Student Conference.
- AMP Student Summer Conference A conference bringing students from Alliance institutions together to share experiences and meet graduate students studying science, engineering, and mathematics. Students are exposed to minority scientists and other role models and present research projects resulting from their Summer Internship Program.
- AMP Institution Mentoring Program A program involving AMP Scholars and faculty mentors in

- academic guidance activities. Faculty mentors provide assistance in academic and other school-related matters.
- AMP Drop-In Centers A Center at each Alliance institution designed to assist students taking science, engineering, and mathematics courses. These Centers are locations of group study sessions in all of the sciences and are equipped with computers and appropriate software. They are staffed by faculty and students and some have a full-time director.
- AMP Faculty Conferences A series of conferences bringing science and engineering faculty from Alliance institutions together to discuss and make recommendations concerning student retention, curriculum reform, and student progress in the science "gatekeeping" courses. Notable speakers are invited to give a national perspective on these issues.
- Summer Bridge Program A summer program for entering freshmen planning to study science, engineering, and mathematics at Alliance institutions. Program participants receive academic enrichment, attend weekly seminars and career counseling sessions, and engage in mentoring and orientation activities.
- Annual Southeastern AMP Student Conference and Scientific Exhibit Competition An annual conference and scientific exhibit competition bringing NSF AMP students from throughout the United States together to share successes and problems faced by minority students. A forum is provided to showcase student research.

THE ALABAMA SEM SCHOLARS PROGRAM



1995 AMP Scholar Graduates

The center of the Alabama Alliance for Science, Engineering, Mathematics, and Science Education project is the AMP Scholars Program, which changed to the Science, Engineering, and Mathematics (SEM) Scholars Program in Summer 1996. In 1991, the initial year of the Alliance, 18 freshmen were recruited to form a core of high achieving student leaders within Alliance institutions. They were given tuition scholarships and became known as AMP Scholars. responsibilities were to serve as tutors in the Science and Engineering Drop-In Centers and to serve as Alabama AMP Ambassadors. They served as role models for their peers and helped to recruit students to their institutions to major in science, engineering, or mathematics. During the summer term of each year, many SEM Scholars participated in the Summer Internship Programs at The University of Alabama at Birmingham and Alabama A&M University/The University of Alabama in Huntsville. The Internship Program provided hands-on research experience under the direction of an active research mentor and an opportunity to enter research projects in scientific competition. The regular undergraduate training in science, engineering, and mathematics, combined with

research experience acquired in the Internship Program, increases greatly the likelihood that SEM Scholars will be successful in graduate programs.
